Dr. Tracy Radosevic will deliver a dramatic presentation of the Gospel of Mark in its entirety. In addition to being an E.I. Professor of Practical Theology and Religious Education, Dr. Radosevic is an internationally acclaimed biblical storyteller, educator, and retreat leader. She earned an M.A. in Religious Education from Duke Divinity School, an M.A. in Storytelling from East Tennessee State University, and a D.Min.—focusing on spirituality for life together with a special emphasis on digital storytelling—from Wesley Theological Seminary.

We know that the earliest gospels circulated in oral form as collections of stories about Jesus, stories learned by heart and shared by the people of faith with one another. This present experience borrows from that ancient tradition, making use of dramatic space, voice, and embodiment so that you may visualize the events and characters of Mark's gospel much as the first believers experienced it: as an invitation to join the centurion at the foot of the cross in declaring, "Truly this was the Son of God!"
