

USING A to Z

A to Z is a tool for identifying journal titles of interest to your research and for locating them (in the library or electronically online) in order to obtain full-text articles

At Knott Library: From desktop, click on the “**A to Z**” icon.

From home: Go to www.stmarys.edu
select “**Knott Library**” and click on “**Electronic Resources**,” then on “**A to Z**.”

Note: some electronic journals will require a special password and can be accessed only with assistance from a librarian.

Once you are in **A to Z**:

1. Find journal title(s) by Title, Subject or Keyword

This will show titles that fit your criteria and where you can find them.

2. Note journal location (online or in library print holdings) and years of coverage

- a) If only Print Holdings are given: Click on the that link to see which years the library owns and retrieve the desired volume from the library stacks to browse or to copy the chosen article.
- b) If electronic format is available:
 - Select a link to the e-journal or publisher's site in order to browse through issues and look for full-text articles by issue.
 - Select one of the databases to go directly to a search screen to enter terms to search for *specific* full-text articles.
