



Accessing Databases from Off-Campus through Maryland Digital Library



You can use some of the Knott Library periodical databases (listed below) from off-campus by logging in with your library barcode number. Just follow these instructions.

- 1) Go to <http://md-diglib.org/>.
- 2) Click on "Login" from the left-hand column.
- 3) Scroll down under "Remote Access" and click on "St. Mary's Seminary and University."
- 4) Enter the barcode number from the back of your library card in the first login box.
- 5) Enter your last name in the second login box.
- 6) Click on the "Login" button.
- 7) The list of databases available from Maryland Digital Library will display. Select the database you would like to use (ex., ATLA Religion Index).
