**Course Description:**

Ministry-in-Context (MIC) is the culminating and integrating component of the MACM degree. It includes a supervised field placement of approximately 10 hours/week (minimum of 120 hours total) and a bi-weekly theological reflection seminar with Dr. Fosarelli with all other MIC students. Students must have completed at least 30 hours toward the degree.

**Course Requirements:**

- Students should expect to read *at most* 750 of required reading.
- Students should expect to write *at most* 20-25 double-spaced pages. These will be comprised of the following:
  1. Final paper describing semester experience; guidelines will be given with syllabus – 90% of final grade
  2. At least 120 hours of documented activities outside the classroom
- Class participation – 10% of final grade
