#### **Course Description:**

This course is meant for Catholic students in leadership positions at their parishes; it is a requirement for students in the Pastoral Associate Fellowship Program.

#### **Course Requirements:**

  - 1. 5-7 summary paper of sessions attended at the MAC -25% of final grade
  - 2. 4-6 page book report on *Co-Workers in the Vineyard of the Lord* 20% of final grade
  - 3. 10-12 page paper analyzing lay ecclesial leadership issues 40% of final grade
