		This series contains the surviving correspondence of Fr. Fenlon and has been organized into two subseries: general and family. The general subseries encompasses letters from fellow Sulpicians, alumni of Sulpician institutions, personal friends, and professional associates. For ease of access, correspondence with women religious can be found in subject files organized by religious community. Incoming and outgoing correspondence have been separated and organized in alpha-chron order, c. 1903-1943. Correspondence with Sulpician institutions is located in the subject files series. Correspondence regarding Fr. Fenlon's work at the National Catholic War Council/National Catholic Welfare Conference has been placed in the series created for the organization.

Shortly after his conversion in 1933 he took up residence at St. Mary's Seminary in Baltimore, where he remained until his death in 1945. He is buried in the Sulpician cemetery in Catonsville, MD.
