

SL 646: Liturgy in the Early Centuries of the Church

This course provides study of the early sources and descriptions of the liturgical life of the early centuries of the Church, with focus on the development of the Order of the Mass and the earliest liturgical books of the early Medieval period. Particular attention will be given to the earliest primary sources of the Church Fathers.
